Organization of the fifty-fifth regular session of the General Assembly, adoption of the agenda and allocation of items

Third report of the General Committee

1. At its 4th meeting, on 16 October 2000, the General Committee considered a request submitted by the Netherlands (A/55/234) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled:

“Cooperation between the United Nations and the Organization for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons”.

In this connection, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the item:

- (a) Be included in the agenda;
- (b) Be considered directly in plenary meeting.

2. At the same meeting, the General Committee considered a request submitted by the representatives of Algeria, Finland, Namibia, Poland, Singapore and Venezuela (A/55/235) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled:

“Follow-up to the outcome of the Millennium Summit”.

In this connection, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the item:

- (a) Be included in the agenda;
- (b) Be considered directly in plenary meeting.

3. Also at the same meeting, the General Committee considered a request submitted by the representatives of Argentina, Australia, Austria, Belize, Brazil, Cambodia, Canada, Chile, China, Côte d’Ivoire, Cyprus, the Czech Republic, the Democratic People’s Republic of Korea, Egypt, Fiji, Finland, France, Indonesia, Ireland, Italy, Japan, the Lao People’s Democratic Republic, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Maldives, Mongolia, Morocco, Myanmar, New Zealand, Oman, Pakistan, Papua New Guinea, Peru, the Philippines, the Republic of Korea, Romania, the Russian Federation, Singapore, South Africa, Spain, Swaziland, Sweden, Thailand, Turkey,

Ukraine, the United States of America and Viet Nam (A/55/236) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled:

“Peace, security and reunification on the Korean peninsula”.

In this connection, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the item:

- (a) Be included in the agenda;
- (b) Be considered directly in plenary meeting.
