Organization of the fifty-eighth regular session of the General Assembly, adoption of the agenda and allocation of items

Second report of the General Committee

1. At its 3rd meeting, on 10 October 2003, the General Committee considered a request submitted by the Secretary-General (A/58/233) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled:

“Financing of the United Nations Mission in Liberia”.

In this connection, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the item:

- (a) Be included in the agenda;
- (b) Be allocated to the Fifth Committee.

2. At the same meeting, the General Committee considered a request submitted by the Netherlands (A/58/234) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled:

“Admission of the International Criminal Court to membership in the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund”.

In this connection, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the item:

- (a) Be included in the agenda;
- (b) Be allocated to the Fifth Committee.

3. At the same meeting, the General Committee considered a request contained in a letter dated 3 October 2003 from the Permanent Representative of Mexico to the United Nations addressed to the President of the General Assembly (A/58/412) and decided to recommend to the Assembly that agenda item 108, entitled “Crime prevention and criminal justice”, which has been allocated to the Third Committee, also be considered directly in plenary meeting for the sole purpose of taking action on the draft United Nations Convention against Corruption.
