I. Introduction

1. The previous recommendations made by the Fifth Committee to the General Assembly under agenda item 107 appear in the reports of the Committee contained in documents A/59/652 and Add.1.
2. The Fifth Committee resumed its consideration of the item at its 57th meeting, on 8 June 2005. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/59/SR.57).
