Organization of the sixtieth regular session of the General Assembly, adoption of the agenda and allocation of items

Third report of the General Committee

1. At its 3rd meeting, on 27 October 2005, the General Committee considered a request submitted by Spain (A/60/233) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled:

“Observer status for the Ibero-American Conference in the General Assembly”

In this connection, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the item:

- (a) Be included in the agenda under heading I (Organizational, administrative and other matters);
- (b) Be allocated to the Sixth Committee.

2. At its 1st meeting, on 13 September 2005, the General Committee decided (A/60/250, para. 54) to defer its consideration of the inclusion of the item entitled “Question of the Comorian island of Mayotte” to a later date. At its 3rd meeting, on 27 October, the General Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that this item be deferred to the sixty-second session of the Assembly and that it be included in the provisional agenda of that session.
