

Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly

Report of the First Committee

- 1. At its 17th plenary meeting, on 20 September 2005, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to allocate item 116 to all the Main Committees for the sole purpose of considering and taking action on their respective tentative programmes of work.
- 2. The Committee considered the item at its 23rd meeting, on 1 November (A/C.1/60/PV.23).
- 3. At the 23rd meeting, the Chairman made a statement and introduced the proposed programme of work contained in conference room paper A/C.1/60/CRP.1.
- 4. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted its proposed programme of work and timetable for 2006 annexed to the present report.
- 5. The First Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:
