## **Membership of the Special Committee**

- 1. At its 12th meeting, on 3 September 2008, the Chairman of the Special Committee drew attention to the letter dated 31 July 2008 addressed to him by the Permanent Representative of Ecuador (A/AC.109/2008/20) and the draft decision submitted by him (A/AC.109/2008/L.16).
- 2. At the same meeting, statements were made by the representatives of Chile, Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of), Bolivia, Cuba, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines and Ecuador (see A/AC.109/2008/SR.12).
- 3. At the same meeting also, the Special Committee adopted draft decision A/AC.109/2008/L.16 without a vote.

## Recommendation

4. The Special Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:

Increase in the membership of the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples

The General Assembly decides to increase the membership of the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples from twenty-seven to twenty-eight and to appoint Ecuador as a member of the Committee.
