Paragraph 5 *should read*

5. In accordance with General Assembly resolution 52/12 B, the Deputy Secretary-General assists the Secretary-General in managing the operations of the Secretariat and supports the Secretary-General in ensuring intersectoral and inter-institutional coherence of activities and programmes. The main function of the Deputy Secretary-General is to assist the Secretary-General in overseeing the day-to-day operations of the Secretariat and to ensure coherence of its activities and programmes. The role of the Deputy Secretary-General focuses on strategic management and cross-cutting management policy, ensuring the coordination of key management matters. The Deputy Secretary-General is the Chair of the Management Performance Board as well as of the Management Committee, which is the primary mechanism for ensuring the effective coordination and consideration of internal reform and cross-cutting management matters requiring strategic direction from the Secretary-General.
