Navy and Marine Corps.

Air forces (column 4): The budget of the Department of the Air Force.

Other combat forces (column 5): Not applicable – all active and reserve military forces are

financed from the above military budgets.

Central support and administration:

Agencies (column 6): The budgets of defence agencies (Office of the Secretary

of Defense, Defense Logistics Agency, Defense Information Systems Agency, Defense Contract Audit Agency, etc), which provide defence-wide support and

general administration.
