Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 26th meeting, on 10 March 2010, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/64/101/Add.1) concerning a vacancy in the membership of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions as a result of the resignation of Nagesh Singh (India). By that note the Fifth Committee was informed of the nomination by the Government of India and endorsement by the Group of Asian States of Anupam Ray (India) to fill the remainder of the term of office of Mr. Singh, which expires on 31 December 2010.

At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint Anupam Ray (India) as a member of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions for a term of office beginning on _____ 2010¹ and ending on 31 December 2010 (see para. 3 below).
