

Observer status in the General Assembly for the Council of Presidents of the General Assembly

Report of the Sixth Committee

I. Introduction

- 1. The item entitled "Observer status in the General Assembly for the Council of Presidents of the General Assembly" was included in the agenda of the sixty-fourth session of the General Assembly at the request of Saint Lucia, Saudi Arabia and Ukraine.
- 2. At its 52nd plenary meeting, on 1 December 2009, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include the item in its agenda and to allocate it to the Sixth Committee.
- 3. The Sixth Committee considered the item at its 26th and 27th meetings, on 9 and 14 December 2009. The views of the representatives who spoke during the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.6/64/SR.26 and 27).
- 4. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it a letter dated 12 November 2009 from the Permanent Representatives of Saint Lucia, Saudi Arabia and Ukraine to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General (A/64/235).

II. Consideration of draft resolution A/C.6/64/L.20

5. At the 26th meeting, on 9 December, the representative of Saint Lucia, on behalf of Saint Lucia, Saudi Arabia and Ukraine, introduced a draft resolution entitled "Observer status in the General Assembly for the Council of Presidents of the General Assembly" (A/C.6/64/L.20).





- 6. At the 27th meeting, on 14 December, the representative of Saudi Arabia, on behalf of Saint Lucia, Saudi Arabia and Ukraine, withdrew draft resolution A/C.6/64/L.20.
- 7. At the same meeting, the Sixth Committee concluded its consideration of the item without taking action.
