## Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly

### Report of the First Committee

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 17 September 2010, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to allocate item 118 to all the Main Committees for the sole purpose of considering and taking action on their respective tentative programmes of work for 2011.
2. The First Committee considered the item at its 23rd meeting, on 29 October 2010 (see A/C.1/65/PV.23).
3. At the 23rd meeting, the Chairman made a statement and introduced the proposed programme of work.
4. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted its proposed programme of work and timetable for 2011, annexed to the present report.
5. The First Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:
