Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Committee on Contributions

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 16 September 2011, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-sixth session the item entitled “Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Committee on Contributions” and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.

2. At its 16th meeting, on 4 November 2011, the Fifth Committee had before it the following documents:

(a) Note by the Secretary-General concerning the vacancies in the membership of the Committee on Contributions that would occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of six of its members on 31 December 2011 (A/66/102);

(b) Note by the Secretary-General containing the names of six persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment or reappointment to the Committee on Contributions for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2012 (A/C.5/66/4).

3. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint NneNne Iwuji-Eme (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland), Nikolay Lozinskiy (Russian Federation), Hae-yun Park (Republic of Korea), Gönke Roscher (Germany), Henrique da Silveira Sardinha Pinto (Brazil) and Sun Xudong (China) as members of the Committee on Contributions for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2012 (see para. 4).
