Administrative and budgetary coordination of the United Nations with the specialized agencies and the International Atomic Energy Agency

Report of the Fifth Committee

I. Introduction

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 21 September 2012, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-seventh session the item entitled “Administrative and budgetary coordination of the United Nations with the specialized agencies and the International Atomic Energy Agency” and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
2. The Fifth Committee considered the item at its 4th and 17th meetings, on 9 October and 7 December 2012. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee’s consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/67/SR.4 and 17).
3. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it a note by the Secretary-General transmitting the statistical report of the United Nations System Chief Executives Board for Coordination on the budgetary and financial situation of the organizations of the United Nations system (A/67/215).

II. Consideration of draft decision A/C.5/67/L.3

4. At its 17th meeting, on 7 December, the Committee had before it a draft decision entitled “Budgetary and financial situation of the organizations of the United Nations system”, submitted following informal consultations by the representative of the United Republic of Tanzania and Rapporteur of the Committee (A/C.5/67/L.3).



5. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft decision A/C.5/67/L.3 without a vote (see para. 6).

III. Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

6. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:

Budgetary and financial situation of the organizations of the United Nations system

The General Assembly takes note of the note by the Secretary-General transmitting the statistical report of the United Nations System Chief Executives Board for Coordination on the budgetary and financial situation of the organizations of the United Nations system.¹
