Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 20 September 2013, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-eighth session the item entitled “Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions” and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.

2. At its 14th meeting, on 1 November 2013, the Fifth Committee had before it the following documents:

(a) Note by the Secretary-General concerning the vacancies in the membership of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions that would occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of six of its members on 31 December 2013 ([A/68/101/Rev.1](#));

(b) Note by the Secretary-General containing the names of six persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment or reappointment to the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2014 ([A/C.5/68/4](#)).

3. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint Toshihiro Aiki (Japan), Richard Moon (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland), Carlos Ruiz Massieu (Mexico), Devesh Uttam (India), Catherine Vendat (France) and Zhang Wanhai (China) as members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2014 (see para. 4).
