Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Committee on Contributions

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 35th meeting, on 5 May 2014, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/68/102/Add.2) concerning two vacancies in the membership of the Committee on Contributions as a result of the resignations of Sun Xudong (China) and Thomas David Smith (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland). By that note, the Fifth Committee was informed of the nomination by the Government of China and the endorsement by the Group of Asia-Pacific States of Fu Daopeng (China) to fill the remainder of the term of office of Mr. Sun and of the nomination by the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the endorsement by the Group of Western European and other States of Kunal Khatri (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland) to fill the remainder of the term of office of Mr. Smith. Both terms expire on 31 December 2014.

2. At the same meeting, the Fifth Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint Mr. Fu and Mr. Khatri as members of the Committee on Contributions for a term of office beginning on _____ 2014¹ and ending on 31 December 2014 (see para. 3 below).
