Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions**Report of the Fifth Committee***Rapporteur:* Mr. Matthias **Dettling** (Switzerland)

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 19 September 2014, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-ninth session the item entitled “Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions” and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.

2. At its 11th meeting, on 7 November 2014, the Fifth Committee had before it the following documents:

(a) Note by the Secretary-General concerning the vacancies in the membership of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions that would occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of five of its members on 31 December 2014 ([A/69/101](#));

(b) Note by the Secretary-General containing the names of five persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment or reappointment to the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2015 ([A/C.5/69/5](#)).

3. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint Pavel Chernikov (Russian Federation), Ali A. Ali Kurer (Libya), Dietrich Lingenthal (Germany), Fernando de Oliveira Sena (Brazil) and David Traystman (United States of America) as members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2015 (see para. 4).
