## **Report of the Fifth Committee**

1. At its 33rd and 34th meetings, on 24 and 27 March 2015, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement submitted by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/69/19) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/69/L.55. At the 33rd meeting, the Chair of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions introduced the related report of that Committee (A/69/826). The draft decision submitted by the Chair following informal consultations coordinated by the representative of India (A/C.5/69/L.31) was before the Committee (see para. 4).

2. The statements and comments made in the course of the Fifth Committee's consideration of this question are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/69/SR.33 and 34).

## **Decision of the Fifth Committee**

3. The Fifth Committee, having considered the statement of programme budget implications submitted by the Secretary-General<sup>1</sup> and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>2</sup> decides to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/69/L.55, additional requirements amounting to \$97,600 under section 28, Public information,
