Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 20th and 23rd meetings, on 13 and 23 December 2016, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement submitted by the Secretary-General on the programme budget implications of draft resolution [A/71/L.25](#) ([A/C.5/71/14](#)). At the 20th meeting, the Chair of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions introduced the related report of that Committee ([A/71/668](#)). The draft decision submitted by the Chair following informal consultations coordinated by the representative of India ([A/C.5/71/L.16](#), sect. C) was before the Committee (see para. 3).

2. The statements and comments made in the course of the Fifth Committee's consideration of this question are reflected in the relevant summary records.¹

Decision of the Fifth Committee

3. The Fifth Committee, having considered the statement of programme budget implications submitted by the Secretary-General¹ and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,² decides to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution [A/71/L.25](#), resources amounting to 326,300 United States dollars would be required under section 1, Overall policymaking, direction and coordination, of the programme budget for the biennium 2016-2017, representing a charge against the contingency fund, and an amount of 29,400 dollars would be required under section 36, Staff assessment, of the programme budget for the biennium 2016-2017, to be offset by an equivalent amount under income section 1, Income from staff assessment.
