I. FINANCIAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 1967

1. I have the honour to submit herewith my financial report for the year ended 31 December 1967 together with the audited accounts of the United Nations Development Programme for the year ended 31 December 1967 and the report of the Board of Auditors. The accounts are comprised of four statements (I through IV) certified by the United Nations Board of Auditors and are supported by eight schedules.

2. This submission is made in conformity with the decision of the General Assembly ("other decisions" relative to resolution 2196 (XXI)) to accept the recommendation of the Fifth Committee (A/6596), and with articles 24.6 and 25.2 of the United Nations Development Programme (Special Fund) Financial Regulations.

3. Separate reports on the consolidated financial position of the United Nations Development Programme (Special Fund) and the United Nations Development Programme (Technical Assistance) will be submitted to the Governing Council and to the General Assembly in accordance with resolution 519 A (VI), article 30.3 of the United Nations Development Programme (Technical Assistance) Finance Manual and article 25.3 of the United Nations Development Programme (Special Fund) Financial Regulations.

United Nations Development Programme (Technical Assistance) Account

4. The financial operations of the Technical Assistance Account are presented in statement I, supported by schedules 1 and 2.

5. Statement I provides data on resources and the use of such resources. It shows that total resources available were \$82 373 889 consisting primarily of net contributions pledged (\$60 607 062), local costs income (\$4 375 049), surrenders by participating and executing agencies (\$3 391 863), and a balance (\$11 245 847) which was unencumbered at 31 December 1966.

6. During 1967, all but \$7 356 726 was allocated. Programme allocations were \$62 039 262; allocations towards the administrative budget of the UNDP secretariat were \$5 394 287; and \$4 475 619, issued by the UNDP Revolving Fund in 1966 to participating and executing agencies to carry out contingency activities, was restored to that Fund.

7. Schedule 1 indicates that at 1 January 1967 there were unpaid prior years' pledges by Governments totalling \$18 655 225. In 1967 new pledges were \$60 355 680, a modest increase of \$4 071 440 over 1966. Collections were \$66 511 982 representing 84 per cent of the total amount collectable (\$79 010 905) and \$19 869 713 more than was collected during 1966 (\$46 642 259). The balance of pledges outstanding at 31 December 1967 (\$12 498 923) represents a decrease of \$5 825 986, over the comparable figure (\$18 324 909) at 31 December 1966.

United Nations Development Programme (Special Fund) Account

8. The financial operations of the Special Fund Account are presented in statement II, supported by schedules 3 through 7.

9. Statement II presents a summary of income received and allocations made. Total resources available were \$300 567 846 of which \$170 729 552 represented unallocated resources at 31 December 1966; \$106 549 869 net adjusted income from pledges, including \$12 500 000 pledged by the Government of Sweden for 1969; \$12 832 817 was contributed by recipient Governments towards local costs, \$4 338 261 was the cash counterpart contributions of recipient Governments; and \$7 523 876 was interest earned on investments. Operational exchange losses were \$1 595 707 and were primarily due to the devaluation of currencies.

10. Against these resources, allocations of \$181 529 814 were issued including \$171 919 605 in respect of approved projects and \$9 490 613 towards the administrative budget of the UNDP secretariat. The unallocated resources remaining at 31 December 1967 were therefore \$119 038 032.

11. This amount of \$119 038 032 represents the net assets of the Special Fund Account and is comprised of cash (\$30 745 831) which includes \$4 353 856 held in resident representatives' bank accounts; Government notes and letters of credit (\$89 149 183); investments and loans (\$134 154 018); Governments' pledges receivable (\$158 398 996); and sundry accounts receivable (\$43 669 031) totalling \$456 117 059, less cash (\$331 351 825) which has not been called by participating and executing agencies, and sundry amounts payable (\$5 727 202) totaling \$337 079 027.

12. Investments and loans are detailed in schedule 6 and attention is invited to the summary which groups the portfolio into six broad areas.

13. Schedule 3 lists the status of contributions pledged by country, and reflects the fact that pledges outstanding at 31 December 1967 were \$158 398 996. This amount includes the sum of \$131 789 907 due for the financial years 1968 and 1969. The balance due for 1967 and prior years is therefore \$26 609 089 which represents a decrease of \$7 383 899 over the comparable figure (\$33 992 988) at 31 December 1966. This decrease, coupled with the fact that there was a slight increase in pledges, signifies an improved collection record.

14. Of the balance of \$20 412 106 due in respect of recipient governments' local costs contributions shown in schedule 4, \$2 880 393 was due in respect of 1967 and prior years.

15. As indicated in schedule 5, \$11 352 524 was due from recipient Governments in respect of cash counterpart contributions of which \$2 398 435 was due in respect of 1967 and prior years.

16. At its ninth session, the Governing Council of the Special Fund (E/3717, paragraph 54) adopted the report (SF/L.72) of an informal working group on financial policy, and defined the technical terms of that report. The Governing Council defined earmarkings to include, *inter alia*, "a reserve for the contingency authority given by the Governing Council for use by the Managing Director amounting to 10 per cent of the total earmarkings for each programme but subject to the limitation that the total earmarking approved by the Governing Council for any particular project will not be increased by more than 25 per cent". The Governing Council also defined allocations and, *inter alia*, commented that "allocations of funds are made by the Managing Director under the authority of earmarkings made by the Governing Council" (E/3717, paragraph 54 (C)). Subsequently, the Governing Council decided that increased project costs arising from decisions relating to increases in the level of reimbursement of executing agency overhead costs and to increases in the international salary scales should be covered from the contingency reserve without prejudice to the 25 per cent limitation for individual projects (E/3789, paragraph 68 (c) and E/4150, paragraph 157).

17. The Governing Council of the Special Fund (now the Governing Council of the United Nations Development Programme) thus delegated to me the authority to issue allocations, up to 25 per cent in excess of the Council earmarking for any particular project, with the exceptions specified above, exclusive of allocations for Government cash counterpart contributions which are not included in the Governing Council project earmarkings. The excess of allocations over the Governing Council project earmarkings were to be financed from the earmarkings to the contingency reserve which amounted to ten per cent of project earmarkings.

18. At its third session the Governing Council of the United Nations Development Programme requested the Administrator to prepare and submit to its fourth session a detailed study of future contingency reserve requirements in the light of the suggestion by members that the ten per cent level might exceed current or foreseeable needs. Such a study was presented to the fourth session (DP/SF/L.13) which recommended a retroactive reduction of the level of contingency earmarkings from ten per cent to eight per cent. The Governing Council decided to accept this recommendation (E/4398, paragraph 168 (a)) and thereby released approximately \$14 400 000 from the reserve established for projects approved through the third session.

19. Schedule 7 shows that total excess allocations, including completed projects were \$32 494 664. This amount represents 4.2 per cent of total earmarkings, \$770 610 014 issued by the Governing Council and indicates that the ceiling on the permissive excess of allocations over earmarkings has been observed.

Administrative Budget of the UNDP secretariat

20. The budget estimates for the year 1967 were submitted to the third session of the Governing Council (DP/L.25 and Corr.1). The Council approved the estimates totalling \$14 884 900 and, in order to finance these requirements, authorized the issue of allocations of \$9 490 613 and \$5 394 287 from the resources of the UNDP (SF) Account and the UNDP (TA) Account respectively (E/4297, paragraph 141 (b), (d)).

21. As shown in statement III and schedule 8, the total obligations incurred against these resources for the year 1967 (exclusive of the operating costs of field offices payable by Governments of \$2 246 555) were \$14 694 976. Unobligated resources of \$189 924, plus other income of \$133 788, a total of \$323 712, were surrendered to the two components of the United Nations Development Programme.

22. Schedule 8 reveals that section 4 of the budget (other general expenses) was over-encumbered by a total of \$127 743. In accordance with the decision reached by the Governing Council when it approved the budget estimates that "the Administrator may transfer credits between sections only with the authorization of the Governing Council, such authorizations to be obtained, if necessary, by canvassing members through correspondence" (E/4297, paragraph 141 (c)), during December 1967, I requested by letter the approval of members of the Council to transfer \$100 000 from section 1 (personal services) to section 4 (other general expenses). All members who replied consented to the transfer. At the time I communicated the request to members, it was not possible to make a more precise determination of what was needed under section 4 and thus it became necessary, after the closing of the accounts, to request members of the Governing Council to authorize a further transfer of \$27 743 from section 1 to section 4. I have communicated this request to members by a Note dated 15 April 1968.

23. During 1967, an *ex-gratia* payment representing an overpayment of salary of \$538 was approved. The details of this payment have been provided to the Board of Auditors.

United Nations Development Programme Revolving Fund

24. The 1967 operations of the Revolving Fund are summarized in statement IV. The statement shows that the unencumbered balance of the Fund at 31 December 1966 was \$1 996 681. During 1967 resources of \$5 692 719 were returned to the Fund. Allocations issued were \$6 151 528 leaving a balance of \$1 537 872 available for allocation at 31 December 1967.

25. The costs of preparatory assistance missions authorized in connexion with the appraisal and preparation of government requests for Special Fund assistance which did not materialize in approved projects amounted to \$119 596 and were charged to the Special Fund Account. The allocations issued for those missions were withdrawn and the actual costs thereof were applied against the earmarking of \$120 000 approved by the Governing Council (E/4297, paragraph 108 (e)) for this purpose.

II. REPORT OF THE BOARD OF AUDITORS TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE UNDP ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 1967

1. The Administrator submitted for audit the following four statements supported by eight schedules:
 - A. United Nations Development Programme (Technical Assistance) Account
Statement I. Status of income and allocations as at 31 December 1967;
 - B. United Nations Development Programme (Special Fund) Account
Statement II. Status of income and allocations as at 31 December 1967;
 - C. United Nations Development Programme Administrative Budget of the secretariat
Statement III. Status of funds as at 31 December 1967;
 - D. United Nations Development Programme Revolving Fund
Statement IV. Status of funds as at 31 December 1967.

A. United Nations Development Programme (Technical Assistance) Account

2. As shown in statement I, the total amount available was \$82 373 889, mainly consisting of (i) net contributions pledged, \$60 607 062, (ii) local costs income, \$4 375 049, (iii) surrenders by participating and executing agencies, \$3 391 863, and the unencumbered balance as at 31 December 1966, \$11 245 847. During 1967, an amount of \$75 017 163 was earmarked mainly comprising (a) Programme earmarking \$62 039 262, (b) earmarking towards the Administrative Budget of the UNDP secretariat, \$5 394 287, (c) operating costs of UNDP field offices payable by Governments, \$2 246 555, and (d) restitution to UNDP Revolving Fund of 1966 contingency allocations, \$4 475 619. The unencumbered balance available at year-end thus amounted to \$7 356 726.

B. United Nations Development Programme (Special Fund) Account

3. During 1967, the Governing Council approved 124 new projects for an aggregate amount of \$127 731 500. After taking into account the earmarkings withdrawn in 1967 for three cancelled projects, the cumulative total of projects approved numbered 778 and the amount earmarked for these projects totalled \$770 610 014. The allocations issued by the Administrator to the executing agencies for approved projects through 31 December 1967 amounted to \$674 917 556. Remittances to the executing agencies totalled \$376 148 456.

As at 31 December 1967, the field work on 176 projects involving an amount of \$126 829 628 earmarked by the Governing Council had been completed.

4. The following projects were undertaken, but later they were either abandoned or their objectives could not be achieved, with the result that the expenditure incurred turned out to be infructuous.

(i) *Vocational Training Centre—Iran.* A project for the establishment of a vocational Instructor and Foreman Training Centre in Iran continued to be operative from January 1962 to 30 June 1967. The main objectives of the project were to train qualified instructors for the network of training centres and Apprenticeship Section of Industrial Establishment to provide trained supervisory personnel for industrial undertakings and to co-ordinate all efforts in regard to vocational training of instructors, supervisory personnel and workers.

The project terminated without instituting a single course of training as no students were forthcoming to take up the course as the Institute had no effective links with industry. An expenditure of \$741 538 was incurred during the period of 5½ years the project remained operative. It is felt that considerable expenditure could have been avoided if the need for continuing the project was assessed at an earlier date.

(ii) *Technological Research Institute—La Paz, Bolivia.* The project was approved in January 1963, but two years later it had to be cancelled on the grounds of change in the attitude of the Government towards the project as also its inability to pay the local counterpart funds and other local circumstances. Expenditure on this project amounted to \$34 890.

(iii) *Survey of Rock Salt Deposits in Brazil.* The project for providing Special Fund assistance in carrying out a survey of possible rock salt deposits in private lands in Brazil was approved in January 1962. Five years later and after an expenditure of \$93 877 had been incurred, the project was cancelled at the request of the Government due to the existence of a legal complication in that under the country's Constitution, rights of prospection and mining were reserved in favour of private land owners. The constitutional impediment was known to the Administration prior to the acceptance of the project but it was approved and continued to be operative for five years on the understanding, which did not materialize, that the Government would take steps to remedy the situation.

C. United Nations Development Programme Administrative Budget of the secretariat

5. The obligations incurred, excluding costs of field offices chargeable to Governments, amounted to \$14 694 976. These obligations were apportioned between UNDP (SF) and UNDP (TA) as under:

The costs of field offices charged to Governments amounted to \$2 246 555 as against \$1 762 655 in the year 1966.

D. United Nations Development Programme Revolving Fund

6. During the year 1967, the Administrator issued allocations for an amount of \$6 151 528 as shown in statement IV. The unencumbered balance of the fund as on 31 December 1966 was \$1 996 681 and during 1967, \$5 692 719 were reimbursed to the fund. The available balance for allocation as at 31 December 1967 thus amounted to \$1 537 872.

7. *Contributions receivable.* The position of the arrears as at 31 December 1967 is indicated below:
