B. REPORT OF THE BOARD OF AUDITORS

United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees

- 1. The United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees submitted the following financial statements together with the relevant schedules for audit certification.
 - I. Consolidated statement of assets and liabilities as at 31 December 1967;
 - II. Income and expenditure statement for the year ended 31 December 1967, excluding indemnification funds;
 - III. Income and expenditure of the indemnification funds for the year ended 31 December 1967, including cumulative totals.

Two new schedules, 5 and 6, were added to the 1967 statements which provided detailed information on allocations and expenditures by area and object.

Loan operations in Greece

2. As the Board felt concerned about the unsatisfactory position of the repayment of the loans in Greece, a thorough study was made of the problem of the reimbursements. The High Commissioner took note of the recommendations offered and assured that further concentrated efforts would be made to improve the procedure. However, arrangements for the establishment of new costing committees, the work of which is essential for the preparation of final loan bonds, are being delayed by ministerial decision as a result of questions concerning a radical change of the whole system and the speeding up of present proceedings. The Agreement for the establishment of a special fund to be created from interest payments made by the refugees, to finance the collection expenses of the repayments, is in its final stages of negotiation. The same applies to the arrangements for the establishment of a uniform repayment rate as recommended by External Audit.

General policy of contracting in Greece

3. The lack of specifications in most of the agreements of housing projects was one of the most important reasons for the increase in construction costs in Greece and the delay in the completion of these works. External Audit offered very detailed comments and suggestions on the subject. The High Commissioner replied that, especially in dealing with Governments, conditions cannot be dictated, but agreements are very often a compromise and the result of long discussions and hard bargaining. Furthermore, contracts have to be adapted to the specific legal and administrative conditions of the country concerned and the High Commissioner naturally can not change governmental procedures, unsatisfectory as they may be from his point of view. He confirmed, however, that the recommendations made by External Audit will be followed as and when new agreements for housing projects are concluded in Greece. In so far as the cost increases under existing

arrangements are concerned, a formula similar to the one proposed by External Audit has been made applicable to all Greek building contracts by a Royal Decree.

4. The administrative expenditure of UNHCR for 1967 was \$3,259,977 (section 18 of the United Nations regular budget). Against this, a sum of \$412,400 was paid to the United Nations in a global amount as a grant-in-aid of the administrative cost. The Executive Committee approved the High Commissioner's proposal to pay this grant-in-aid as far as possible from interest on invested bonds while the balance is financed from the income to the current UNHCR programme for 1967. The amount needed is comprised as follows:

5. The assets of all voluntary funds, emergency and trust funds as at 31 December 1967 totalled \$19,680,604.11. Liabilities totalled \$16,268,244.64. The assets thus exceeded liabilities by \$3,412,359.47, the breakdown being:

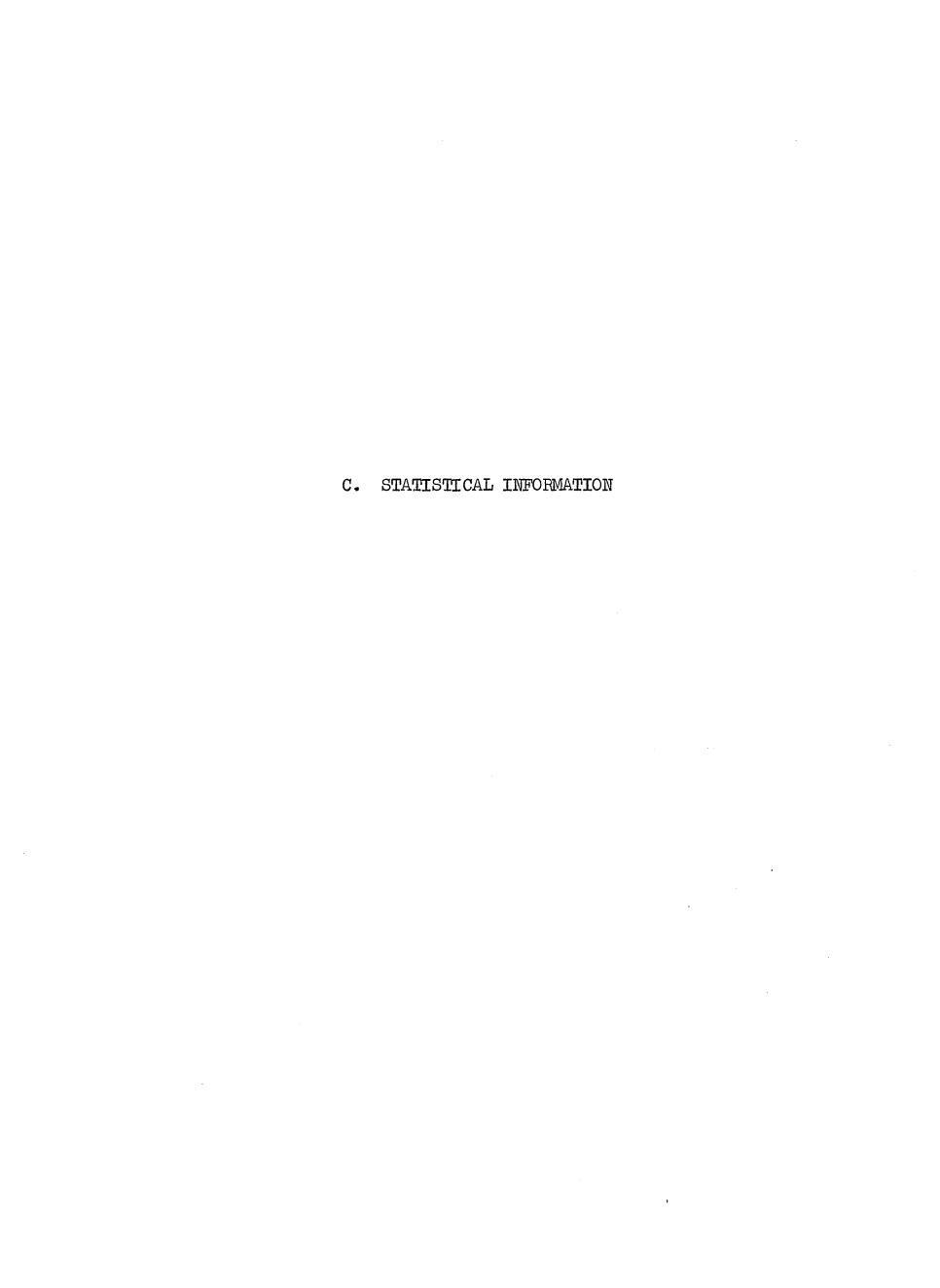
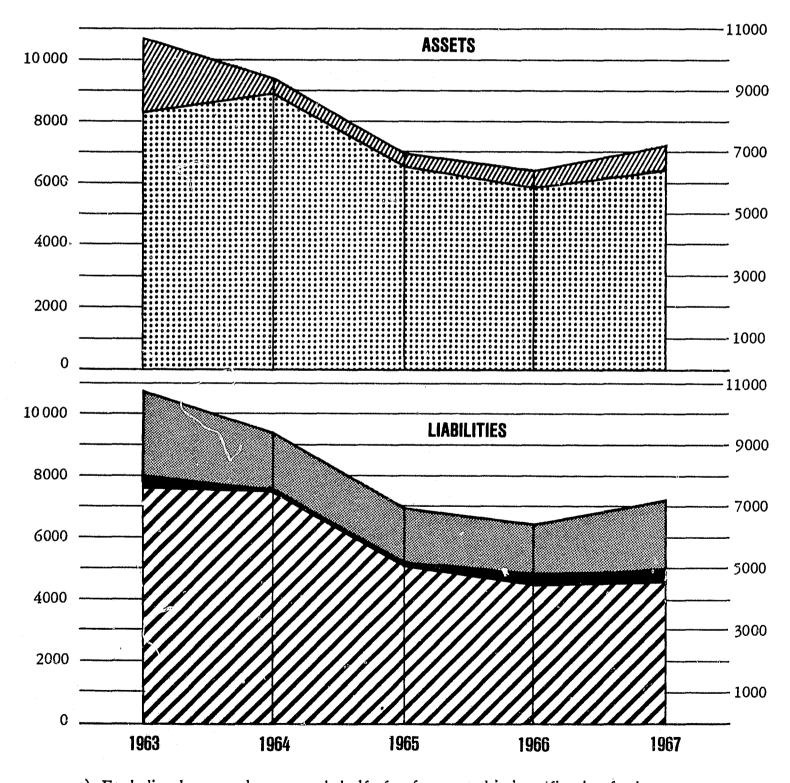

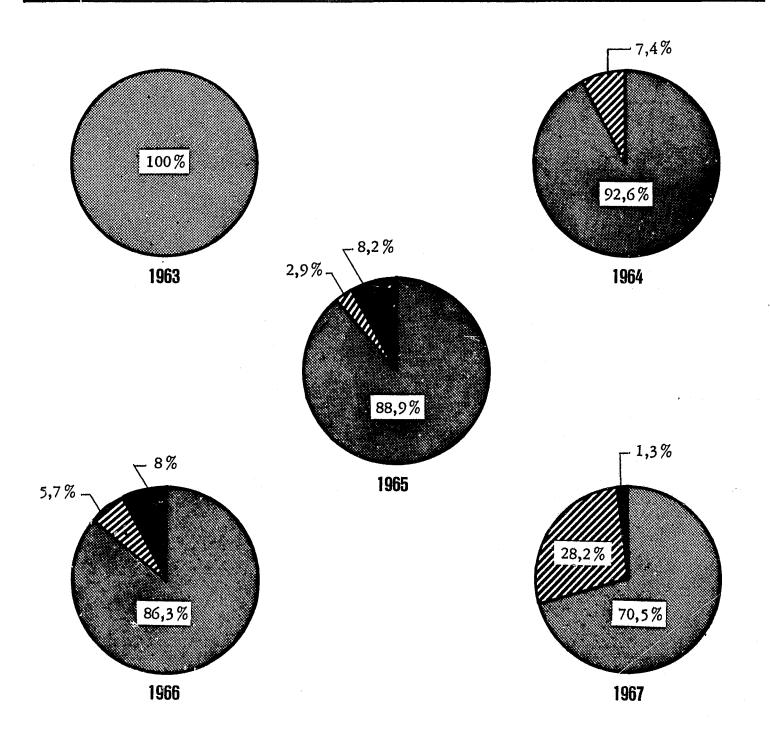

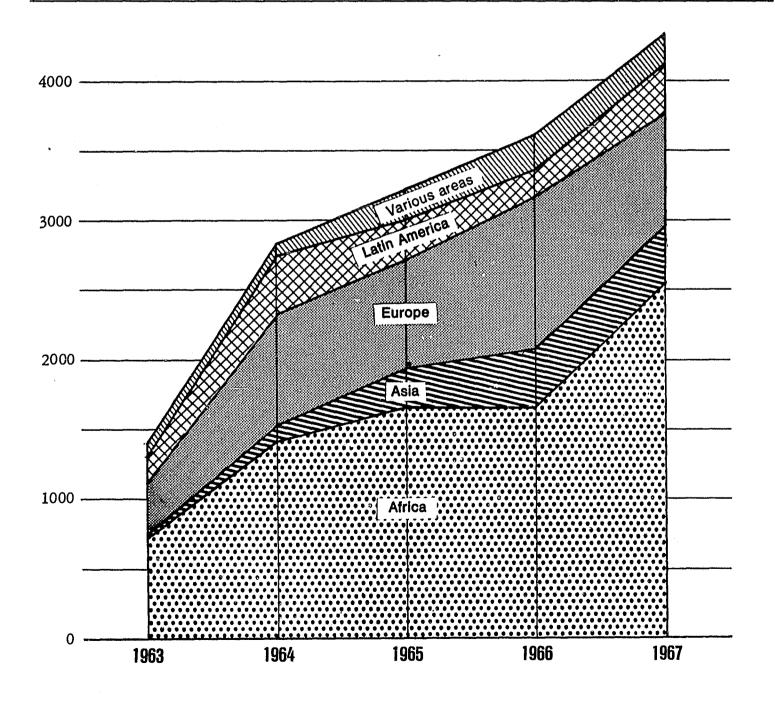
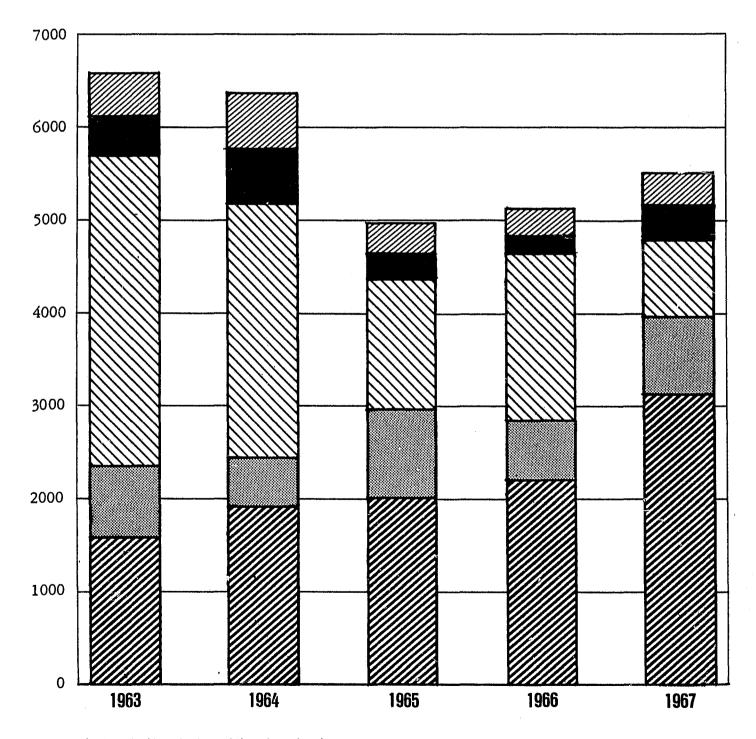

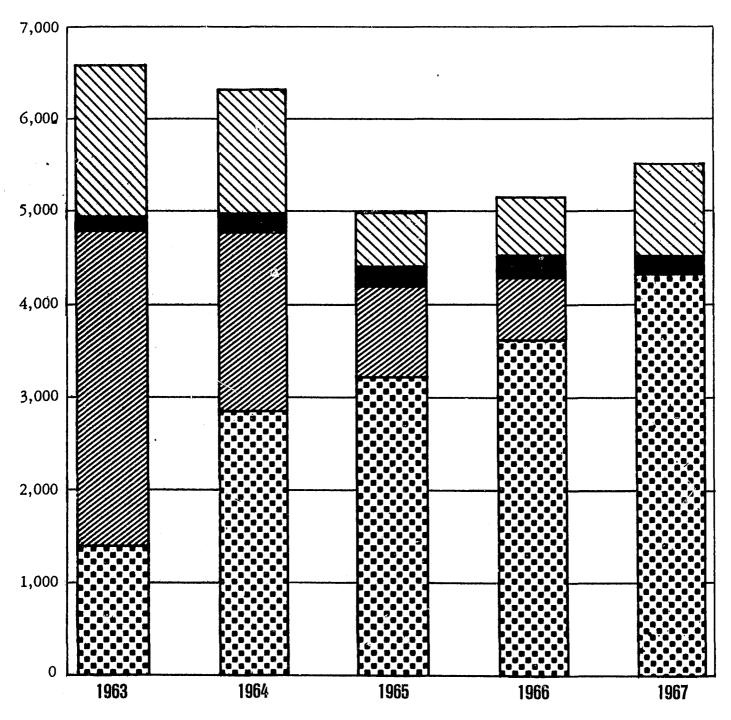
