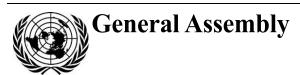

Addendum

- 1. The Secretary-General has received notification of the resignation of Evgeny Kalugin (Russian Federation) from the Committee on Contributions, effective 7 February 2019. Accordingly, the General Assembly will be required to appoint, at its current session, a person to fill the vacancy for the remaining period of the term of office of Mr. Kalugin, which expires on 31 December 2020.
- 2. The Government of the Russian Federation has nominated Vadim Laputin to fill the vacancy arising from the resignation of Mr. Kalugin.
- 3. In a communication dated 26 February 2019, the Secretariat was informed by the Chair of the Group of Eastern European States that the candidature of Mr. Laputin had been endorsed by the Group.
