Addendum

1. The Secretary-General has received notification of the resignation of Yoon Seongmee (Republic of Korea) from the Committee on Contributions, effective 4 April 2019. Accordingly, the General Assembly will be required to appoint, at its current session, a person to fill the vacancy for the remaining period of the term of office of Ms. Yoon, which expires on 31 December 2020.
2. The Government of the Republic of Korea has nominated Na Sang-deok to fill the vacancy arising from the resignation of Ms. Yoon.
3. In a communication dated 16 April 2019, the Secretariat was informed by the Chair of the Group of Asia-Pacific States that the candidature of Mr. Na had been endorsed by the Group.
