

Introduction

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 21 September 2018, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its seventy-third session the item entitled:

"Globalization and interdependence:

- "(a) Globalization and interdependence;
- "(b) International migration and development"

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

- 2. The Second Committee held a substantive debate on the item at its 17th meeting, on 19 October. An account of the Committee's consideration of the item is contained in the relevant summary record. Attention is also drawn to the general debate held by the Committee at its 2nd to 6th meetings, on 8, 9 and 10 October.
