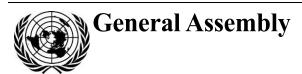

Report of the Second Committee*

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 21 September 2018, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its seventy-third session the item entitled:

"Groups of countries in special situations:

- "(a) Follow-up to the Fourth United Nations Conference on the Least Developed Countries;
- "(b) Follow-up to the second United Nations Conference on Landlocked Developing Countries."

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

- 2. The Second Committee held a substantive debate on the item at its 19th meeting, on 22 October 2018. An account of the Committee's discussion of the item is contained in the relevant summary record. Attention is also drawn to the general debate held by the Committee at its 2nd to 6th meetings, on 8, 9 and 10 October. At the 19th meeting, on 22 October, the Director of the Office of the High Representative for the Least Developed Countries, Landlocked Developing Countries and Small Island Developing States made an introductory statement and subsequently responded to comments made and questions posed by the Chair of the Committee and the representative of Malawi, in his capacity as Chair of the Least Developed Countries.
- 5. At the 23rd meeting, on 8 November, the representative of the United States of America made a statement with regard to the draft resolutions before the Committee.³
- 6. At the 27th meeting, on 3 December, the representative of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela made a statement with regard to the draft resolutions adopted by the Committee.⁴
