- 1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 20 September 2019, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its seventy-fourth session the item entitled:
 - "Operational activities for development:
 - "(a) Operational activities for development of the United Nations system;
 - "(b) South-South cooperation for development"

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.
