

Seventy-fourth session Agenda item 114 (a) Elections to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other elections

Election of members of the Committee for Programme and Coordination

Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. In accordance with Economic and Social Council resolution 2008 (LX) and General Assembly decision 42/450, the members of the Committee for Programme and Coordination are nominated by the Council and elected by the Assembly.
- 2. The membership of the Committee in 2019 is as follows (the term of office expires on 31 December in the year indicated): Angola (2021); Argentina (2021); Bangladesh (2019); Belarus (2020); Botswana (2020); Brazil (2020); Bulgaria (2020); Burkina Faso (2020); Cameroon (2020); Chad (2020); Chile (2020); China (2019); Cuba (2020); Egypt (2019); Eritrea (2019); Ethiopia (2021); France (2021); Germany (2020); Haiti (2019); India (2020); Iran (Islamic Republic of) (2020); Italy (2020); Japan (2020); Pakistan (2020); Paraguay (2021); Portugal (2020); Republic of Korea (2019); Republic of Moldova (2020); Russian Federation (2021); Senegal (2019); United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (2020); and United States of America (2020).
- 3. The General Assembly, at its seventy-fourth session, will be called upon to elect seven members, on the nomination of the Economic and Social Council, to fill the vacancies in the Committee that will occur on 31 December 2019 upon the expiration of the terms of office of the following members: Bangladesh, China, Egypt, Eritrea, Haiti, Republic of Korea and Senegal.
- 4. In accordance with General Assembly decision 42/450, the vacancies are to be filled as follows:
 - (a) Three members from African States;
 - (b) Three members from Asia-Pacific States;
 - (c) One member from Latin American and Caribbean States.

¹ There are two vacancies for a term beginning on the date of election by the General Assembly: one member from Latin American and Caribbean States for a term expiring on 31 December 2020; and one member from Western European and other States for a term expiring on 31 December 2021.





- 5. By its decision 2019/201 C, the Economic and Social Council nominated the following six Member States for election by the General Assembly at its seventy-fourth session for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2020: China, Comoros, Liberia, Mauritania, Republic of Korea and Uruguay.
- 6. The geographical distribution of the nominated Member States is as follows:
 - (a) African States (three vacancies): Comoros, Liberia and Mauritania;
 - (b) Asia-Pacific States (three vacancies): China and Republic of Korea;²
 - (c) Latin American and Caribbean States (one vacancy): Uruguay.
