

Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Committee on Contributions

Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. The previous recommendations made by the Fifth Committee to the General Assembly under agenda item 115 (b) are set out in the reports of the Committee contained in documents A/74/525, A/74/525/Add.1 and A/74/525/Add.2.
- 2. The Fifth Committee resumed its consideration of the item at the second part of the resumed seventy-fourth session, during which it met online owing to the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic. The Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/74/102/Add.3) concerning a vacancy in the membership of the Committee on Contributions as a result of the resignation of Zhang Wei (China). By that note, the Committee was informed of the nomination by the Government of China and the endorsement by the Group of Asia-Pacific States of Lin Shan (China) to fill that vacancy.
- 3. On 22 May, the Chair of the Committee submitted for consideration under silence procedure, in accordance with General Assembly decisions 74/544 and 74/555, a draft decision by which the Committee would recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint Mr. Lin as a member of the Committee on Contributions for a term of office beginning on ¹ and ending on 31 December 2020 (see para. 5).
- 4. On 29 May, the Committee considered the draft decision adopted, in accordance with the process set out in decisions 74/544 and 74/555 (see para. 3). It also noted that it would take note of the decision at its next meeting, to be held after the cessation of the precautionary measures as soon as the circumstances allowed.
