Addendum

1. In paragraph 155 of its report to the General Assembly ([A/76/11](#)), the Committee on Contributions noted that only one Member State, the Central African Republic, was in arrears in the payment of its assessed contributions to the United Nations under the terms of Article 19 of the Charter of the United Nations and had no vote in the Assembly. In addition, the following three Member States were in arrears under the terms of Article 19 but had been permitted to vote in the Assembly until the end of the seventy-fifth session, pursuant to Assembly resolution [75/2](#): Comoros, Sao Tome and Principe and Somalia. In that connection, the Committee decided to authorize its Chair to issue an addendum to the report, if necessary.

2. The Secretary-General has now advised that, of the Member States listed in paragraph 155 of the Committee's report, the Central African Republic has since made a sufficient payment to reduce its arrears below the limit prescribed in Article 19 of the Charter. Thus, the three Member States remaining in arrears under the provisions of that Article are the Comoros, Sao Tome and Principe and Somalia. The related recommendations of the Committee regarding those Member States are contained in paragraphs 130, 135 and 140 of its report.
