

## Situation of human rights in Eritrea

## Note by the Secretariat

- 1. The Human Rights Council, in its resolution 47/2 on the situation of human rights in Eritrea, requested the Special Rapporteur on the situation of human rights in Eritrea, Mohamed Abdelsalam Babiker, to present a report on the implementation of the mandate to the Council at its fiftieth session and to the General Assembly at its seventy-sixth session.
- 2. The report of the Special Rapporteur, covering the period from 5 May 2020 to 28 April 2021, is contained in document A/HRC/47/21. The Special Rapporteur provides therein an overview of the human rights situation in Eritrea and outlines recent developments and some challenges. In the light of the five benchmarks for progress set out by his predecessor, he addresses recommendations to the Government and to the international community with a view to improving the situation of human rights in the country. The Secretariat has the honour to refer the General Assembly to that report.
