Observer status for the Global Environment Facility in the General Assembly

Report of the Sixth Committee

I. Introduction

1. The item entitled “Observer status for the Global Environment Facility in the General Assembly” was included in the provisional agenda of the seventy-sixth session of the General Assembly pursuant to Assembly decision 75/533.
2. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 17 September 2021, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include the item in its agenda and to allocate it to the Sixth Committee.
3. The Sixth Committee considered the item at its 28th meeting, on 10 November 2021. The Committee’s consideration of the item is reflected in the relevant summary record.¹
4. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it a note verbale dated 12 August 2017 from the Permanent Mission of Uruguay to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General ([A/72/195](#)).

II. Consideration of agenda item 172

5. At its 28th meeting, on 10 November, the Chair of the Committee announced that the Bureau had been informed that the delegation of Uruguay had requested that the Committee defer a decision on the request for observer status for the Global Environment Facility in the General Assembly until the seventy-seventh session of the Assembly.
6. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted a draft decision without a vote (see para. 7).
