

Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions

Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 17 September 2021, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its seventy-sixth session the item entitled "Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions" and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
- 2. At its 7th meeting, on 9 November 2021, the Fifth Committee had before it the following documents:
- (a) Note by the Secretary-General concerning the vacancies in the membership of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions that would occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of five of its members on 31 December 2021 (A/76/101);
- (b) Note by the Secretary-General containing the names of five persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment or reappointment to the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2022 (A/C.5/76/4).
- 3. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint or reappoint Yves Eric Ahoussoughemey (Benin), Amjad Qaid Al Kumaim (Yemen), Makiese Kinkela Augusto (Angola), Sharon Brennen-Haylock (Bahamas) and Jakub Chmielewski (Poland) as members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2022 (see para. 4).
