### **Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Committee on Contributions**

#### **Report of the Fifth Committee**

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 17 September 2021, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its seventy-sixth session the item entitled “Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Committee on Contributions” and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.

2. At its 7th meeting, on 9 November 2021, the Fifth Committee had before it the following documents:

(a) Note by the Secretary-General concerning the vacancies in the membership of the Committee on Contributions that would occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of six of its members on 31 December 2021 ([A/76/102](#));

(b) Note by the Secretary-General containing the names of six persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment or reappointment to the Committee on Contributions for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2022 ([A/C.5/76/5](#)).

3. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint or reappoint Syed Yawar Ali (Pakistan), Phologo Kaone Bogatsu (Botswana), Jasminka Dinić (Croatia), Ihor Humennyi (Ukraine), Kitano Mitsuru (Japan) and Thomas Anthony Repasch (United States of America) as members of the Committee on Contributions for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2022 (see para. 4).
