- IS1.1 The estimates under the present income section comprise the global provision requested under section 36, Staff assessment (\$287,291,500, including \$5,295,200 of preliminary recosting) and that portion of the expenditure estimates under income section 3, Services to the public, relating to staff assessment (\$2,065,900).
- IS1.2 All revenue from staff assessment not otherwise disposed of by a specific resolution of the General Assembly is credited to the Tax Equalization Fund established by the Assembly in its resolution 973 (X) A. Member States are given credit from the regular budget portion of staff assessment in the Fund in accordance with the scale of assessments for the regular budget applicable to the financial year concerned.
