International meeting entitled "Stockholm+50: a healthy planet for the prosperity of all – our responsibility, our opportunity"

The General Assembly, recalling its resolutions 75/280 of 24 May 2021 and 75/326 of 10 September 2021 pertaining to the international meeting entitled "Stockholm+50: a healthy planet for the prosperity of all – our responsibility, our opportunity", to be held in Stockholm on 2 and 3 June 2022, decides, without setting a precedent for future international meetings, that States and the European Union speaking at the plenary meetings may each submit a pre-recorded statement of their Head of State or Government, which will be played during the general debate of the international meeting, following its introduction by the presiding officer.
