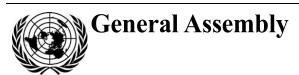

Convening of the second and third sessions of the open-ended working group to elaborate a set of political commitments as a new global framework that will address existing gaps in through-life ammunition management

The General Assembly, recalling its resolution 76/233 of 24 December 2021, in which it decided that the open-ended working group to elaborate a set of political commitments as a new global framework that would address existing gaps in throughlife ammunition management would convene for two 5-day sessions in New York in 2022 and for one 5-day session in Geneva in 2023, decides to convene the second five-day session in 2022 in Geneva and the third five-day session in New York.
