- 1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 16 September 2022, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its seventy-seventh session the item entitled "Countering the use of information and communications technologies for criminal purposes" and to allocate it to the Third Committee.
- 2. The Committee heard an introductory statement and held an interactive dialogue and a general discussion on the item jointly with item 109, entitled "Crime prevention and criminal justice", and item 111, entitled "International drug control", at its 5th and 6th meetings, on 3 October 2022. An account of the Committee's consideration of the item is contained in the relevant summary records.¹
- 3. At the 5th meeting, on 3 October 2022, the representative of the New York Office of the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime made an introductory statement and responded to questions posed and comments made by the representatives of the European Union, Belarus and Mexico.
- 4. No proposals were submitted under this item.
