

## Letter dated 24 January 2024 from the Permanent Representative of the United Arab Emirates to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

## Note verbale from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the United Arab Emirates addressed to the Secretary-General

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the United Arab Emirates presents its compliments to the Secretariat.

I write in reference to the note verbale dated 9 January 2023 from the Permanent Mission of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General (A/77/691). The United Arab Emirates categorically rejects the claim in the aforementioned note verbale that the State's straight baselines are contrary to the international law of the sea.

Those lines were delineated in Cabinet Resolution No. 35 (2022) and, in accordance with the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea, article 16, paragraph 2, they were deposited with the Secretary-General on 28 July 2022 and 31 August 2022.

The United Arab Emirates stresses that the straight baselines that it has deposited with the Secretary-General entail all the legal effects guaranteed by the international law of the sea in its maritime areas in the Arabian Gulf and the Gulf of Oman.

The United Arab Emirates considers the present note to be an official document and asks the Secretariat to publish and circulate it in accordance with United Nations procedures.

The Permanent Mission of the United Arab Emirates to the United Nations in New York takes this opportunity to convey to the Secretariat the assurances of its highest consideration.
