COMMUNICATION FROM THE CONSULATE-GENERAL OF LEBANON

The following letter has been received from the Consulate-General of Lebanon.

Consulat Général du Liban en Palestine Jerusalem, July 14, 1947.

Sir:

I have the honour to inform you that your communication dated the 9th July, 1947, was transmitted to my Government.

I am now directed by my Government to convey to you their acceptance of your invitation to present oral testimony on the Palestine question. With regard to the place of the testimony, I am advised that the majority of the arab States favour the Lebanon as a meeting place for this purpose.
