**SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON PALESTINE**

COMMUNICATION ADDRESSED BY THE PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE  
OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE CONSUL-GENERAL OF  
LEBANON

The following letter has been sent by the Personal  
Representative of the Secretary-General to the Consul-General  
of Lebanon:

"United Nations

Palestine  
10 July 1947.

Sir:

I have the honour to ask you, in view of the fact that  
the kingdom of the Yemen has no representative here, to be  
good enough to convey to the kingdom of the Yemen the invita-  
tion of the United Nations Special Committee on Palestine to  
that kingdom to present to the Committee, in such manner as  
may be found appropriate, its views on the question of Pales-  
tine.

Similar invitations have been addressed to Egypt, Iraq,  
Lebanon, Saudi-Arabia, Syria and Transjordan.

Would you further be so kind as to inform the kingdom  
of the Yemen that if it should be the desire of that kingdom  
to present oral testimony on the question, this should be  
done at the same time and place as may be mutually convenient  
to the spokesmen of the participating countries and the Com-  
mittee in one of the neighboring Arab states prior to the  
Committee's departure for Geneva, or at Geneva after its  
arrival there.
