ADDENDUM TO THE REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

The following two additions should be made to the Report:

1. Page 140, line 7, insert "in an appreciable degree" between "development" and "should".
2. Page 165, add at the bottom of the page:
"3. The above reservations and observations have not been communicated to all the other members before the signing of the Report."
3. Page 18, add a new paragraph 80. as follows:

"The representatives also recorded their appreciation of the assistance in the furnishing of information necessary to their full understanding of the situation in Palestine, as well as the attentions to their personal convenience in carrying out their enquiry, so freely given them by H. E. Sir Alan Cunningham, the High Commissioner of Palestine, and the officials of the Palestine administration while in Palestine; and to the Government of Lebanon for the unstinted hospitality extended to them during their stay in that country."

The former paragraph 80. will become paragraph 81.
