COMMUNICATION FROM THE SYRIAN URTHODOX METROFOLITAN JERUSALEM

Your Lordship,

I am very pleased to express my gratitude for your kind letter of 9th July 1947 in which you request me to give an evidence on the religious interests of the Syrian Orthodox Church in Palestine and hereby beg to state the following:-

It is a historical fact that the Christian Syrians and their Orthodox Church have been existing and functioning in Palestine since the beginning of Christianity and in spite of all historical events their rights as Christians have been respected and well preserved until our times.

We therefore request that the rights and interests of the Syrian Church in Falestine be well respected, preserved and guaranteed by all responsible authorities.

Although Falestine on the whole is the nativity of Christianity yet the Holy Flaces, specially, Jerusalem, Bethlehem, Nazareth and the Bake of Tiberious are of more and immense interest to the Christians than any other Communities.

From the aforesaid it will appear that the present Christian Institutions and Churches in Palestine represent all the Christians of the world and are therefore requested to safeguard and protect the Holy Places by all means.

It is hereby hoped that your Honourable Committee as well as any other authorities

i) Shall consider and respect the rights, freedom and interests of the Christians in Falestine

- ii) keep up to the 'Status wuo' in the Holy Flaces
- iii) Dafeguard and guarantee the safety of the Christians in Palestine and finally respect their Ecclestiastical Courts and their jurisdiction.

I pray God almighty that peace may be established in Falestine and all men live in freedom and happiness and remain
