Dear Sir,

We venture to approach you in order to lay down once
more in writing the urgent plea put forward by our representatives
in their oral evidence at the public hearing of July 11th:

That you may leave nothing untried to bring about the
speedy transfer to Palestine of the Jewish children still in
Europe and of those remaining behind in the Cyprus Camps.

We wish to assure you again that the Women's Organisa-
tions united in our Council will do their utmost for the smooth
absorption of these children.
