REFERENCE LIBRARY ON PALESTINE

The purpose of the Reference Library on Palestine is to assist members of delegations and the Secretariat in their study of the Palestine question.

The material available in the Library consists of documents issued by (a) international organizations; (b) individual governments; (c) the Arab Higher Committee and its predecessors and the Jewish Agency for Palestine and its predecessors, and also of a small collection of reference works and books by individual authors. The Library also contains the records of the Special Session on Palestine of the General Assembly, and the full documentation of the Special Committee on Palestine, including copies of all written testimony presented to the Committee, verbatim records of its meetings, documents and maps made available by the Government of Palestine, and English translations of clippings from the local press.
