The General Assembly, recalling its resolutions [74/247](#) of 27 December 2019 and [75/282](#) of 26 May 2021, and taking note of the decision of the Ad Hoc Committee to Elaborate a Comprehensive International Convention on Countering the Use of Information and Communications Technologies for Criminal Purposes to resume its work at a later date with a view to concluding its work and providing the draft convention to the General Assembly at its seventy-eighth session, decides that the Ad Hoc Committee shall hold a reconvened concluding session of up to 10 days in New York on [date], tentatively, and requests the Secretary-General to provide the necessary support and services for that purpose.
