I. Opening of the session

A. Opening and duration of the session

The Ad Hoc Committee to Elaborate a Comprehensive International Convention on Countering the Use of Information and Communications Technologies for Criminal Purposes held its first session at Headquarters from 28 February to 11 March 2022.
