Egypt*: draft resolution

Report of the Conference on Disarmament

The General Assembly,

<u>Having considered</u> the report of the Conference on Disarmament, 1/

<u>Convinced</u> that the Conference on Disarmament, as the single multilateral disarmament negotiating forum of the international community, has the primary role in substantive negotiations on priority questions of disarmament,

<u>Considering</u>, in this respect, that the present international climate should give additional impetus to multilateral negotiations with the aim of reaching concrete agreements,

<u>Welcoming</u> the decision of the Conference on Disarmament to give to its Ad Hoc Committee on a Nuclear Test Ban a mandate to negotiate such a ban,

<u>Noting with satisfaction</u> the results achieved so far on the subject of improved and effective functioning of the Conference on Disarmament, as well as the decision to carry out inter-sessional consultations with a view to achieving consensus on the issue of its membership during the inter-sessional period, and the decision to continue consultations on the issue of the agenda at its 1994 session,

1. <u>Reaffirms</u> the role of the Conference on Disarmament as the single multilateral disarmament negotiating forum of the international community;

2. <u>Welcomes</u> the determination of the Conference on Disarmament to fulfil that role in the light of the evolving international situation with a view to making early substantive progress on priority items of its agenda;

3. <u>Also welcomes</u> the decision of the Conference on Disarmament to give to its Ad Hoc Committee on a Nuclear Test Ban a mandate to negotiate such a ban;

4. <u>Urges</u> the Conference on Disarmament to reach a consensus which results in the expansion of its membership before the start of its 1994 session;

5. <u>Encourages</u> the ongoing review of the agenda, membership and methods of work of the Conference on Disarmament;

6. <u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General to ensure the provision, to the Conference on Disarmament, of additional administrative, substantive and conference support services for its negotiations;

7. <u>Requests</u> the Conference on Disarmament to submit a report on its work to the General Assembly at its forty-ninth session;

8. <u>Decides</u> to include in the provisional agenda of its forty-ninth session an item entitled "Report of the Conference on Disarmament".
