

Australia: draft decision

Disarmament Commission

The General Assembly, recalling its decisions 75/519 A of 7 December 2020 and 75/519 B of 25 March 2021, decides:

- (a) That the Disarmament Commission will hold a substantive session for a period not exceeding three weeks during 2022, namely from 4 to 22 April, and submit a substantive report to the General Assembly at its seventy-seventh session;
- (b) That the Disarmament Commission will hold its organizational session at the beginning of 2022, before the substantive session, to elect its Bureau and address other outstanding organizational matters;
- (c) To include in the provisional agenda of its seventy-seventh session, under the item entitled "Review of the implementation of the recommendations and decisions adopted by the General Assembly at its tenth special session", the sub-item entitled "Report of the Disarmament Commission".
