Non-proliferation of nuclear weapons (continued) (A/5976, A/5986-DC/227,
A/C.1/L.337, A/C.1/L.338)

1. The CHAIRMAN said that a number of delegations were still engaged in informal consultations with a view to producing a draft resolution on the non-proliferation of nuclear weapons which would command unanimous support in the Committee. There were good grounds for hoping that if the discussions were continued for another twenty-four hours some very significant progress might indeed be made. He therefore proposed that the meeting should be adjourned to allow the informal consultations to continue.
