DRAFT INTERNATIONAL DECLARATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS

Synthesized text for article 7 elaborated jointly by the delegations of Cuba, Ecuador, France, Mexico, The Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and Uruguay

No one may be deprived of his freedom (Cuba, Ecuador, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, Uruguay), nor exiled (Cuba, Ecuador, Uruguay), except in the cases and according to the procedure prescribed by prior legislation (Cuba, Ecuador, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, Uruguay).

Anyone deprived of his freedom has the right to be informed without delay of the grounds for his detention, to have the legality of the action taken against him confirmed without delay by a judge and also to have his case brought before the court without undue delay or to be liberated/(Cuba, Ecuador, France, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, Uruguay).

Everyone is entitled to compensation for illegal (Cuba, Ecuador, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, Uruguay) arrest or (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics) deprivation of liberty (Cuba, Ecuador, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, Uruguay).

No one may be deprived of his freedom on account merely of failure to carry out obligations of a purely civil character (Cuba, Ecuador, Mexico, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, Uruguay) or violation of a work contract (Cuba, Ecuador, Mexico, Uruguay).

Note: The following emendments to article 7 are consequently withdrawn: Union of Soviet Socialist Republics (E/800), Cuba (A/C.3/224), France (A/C.3/244), Mexico (A/C.3/266), Uruguay (A/C.3/268). The delegation of Panama has not yet had the opportunity to pronounce itself on this text.
