Request for subvention to the Institute resulting from the recommendations of the Board of Trustees of the United Nations Institute for Disarmament Research contained in document A/46/334

Note by the Secretary-General

1. In accordance with the provisions of paragraph 3 of article VIII of the statute of the United Nations Institute for Disarmament Research (UNIDIR), 1/ the recommendation by the Board of Trustees of the Institute for a subvention from the regular budget of the United Nations is hereby transmitted to the General Assembly for approval.

2. The Advisory Board on Disarmament Matters, in its capacity as Board of Trustees of UNIDIR, adopted the 1992 draft programme of work and proposed budget estimates of the Institute. 2/ The Board noted that in the proposed programme budget of the United Nations for the biennium 1992-1993 a non-recurrent provision of \$440,000 was proposed as a grant representing the United Nations subvention to UNIDIR for 1992-1993, and recommended a subvention of \$220,000 from the regular budget of the United Nations for 1992. Notwithstanding the inclusion of the necessary provision in the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1992-1993, a formal request for a

subvention for 1992 of \$220,000 is being submitted to the General Assembly in keeping with established procedure.

3. Should the General Assembly decide to approve the recommendation of the Board of Trustees of UNIDIR, no additional appropriation would be required under section 5 of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1992-1993.
